- Develop a maintenance plan that will ensure the cabinet is cleaned regularly of any debris and dust that may accumulate onto and inside of the cabinet and its components.
- Users must exercise caution and follow all instructions, warnings, and safety guidelines outlined in this manual. Proper training must be implemented to incorporate the use of this cabinet into your Environmental Health and Safety procedures.

If you suspect there is an event occurring inside the cabinet;

A WARNING: DO NOT OPEN THE DOORS. 🔺 CAUTION: Call 9-1-1/Emergency services!

WARNING: In the event you suspect an event occurring inside the cabinet, the user must FIRST inspect the heat-reactive label on the door (located above the paddle latch/handle) of the cabinet prior to opening the doors.



This label will change from SILVER to BLACK once the temperature has reached 120 Degrees Fahrenheit. This is the first indication that an event may be occurring/-taking place.

- A CAUTION: If an event has taken place, follow the steps contained in your EHS policy, contact local fire/rescue/emergency services and inform them that you have a possible Lithium-Ion Battery fire. Inform them of the location, the cabinet contents and follow their instructions. Be sure that the area where the cabinet is located is isolated from any additional personnel who may be unaware of the potential event inside the cabinet.
- A DANGER: After a battery goes into thermal runaway do not open the cabinet until directed by emergency authorities.

IF YOU DO NOT FULLY UNDERSTAND THIS GUIDE AND ARE NOT TRAINED TO WORK WITH LITHIUM BATTERIES, PLEASE DO NOT USE THIS CABINET.



INSPECTIONS

Perform an initial inspection on the Lithium-Ion Battery Charging Safety at the time of delivery to identify any damage that may have occurred during transit and prior to installation* (see warranty details for more information). In the event you identify damage to the cabinet during your initial inspection, please contact Justrite immediately at the information provided below.

Inspect batteries for damage before attempting to charge/store. Do not attempt to charge or store damaged batteries. If batteries are damaged, contact your local battery recycling/disposal experts and follow their directions. Dispose of the damaged batteries according to local, state, and federal regulations.

INSTALLATION

This cabinet must be installed onto a sturdy and level surface, inadequate installation of this cabinet may lead to the cabinet not functioning properly.

Cabinet Dimensions: Exterior (inches) 24x43x18

Cabinet Weight (empty): 157 pounds

Shelf Capacity: 65 pounds of evenly distributed weight

Ensure the installation location is structurally adequate to support the weight of the cabinet.

The area must be well ventilated and installed in accordance with your EHS policies (AWAY from fire escape pathways or emergency exits including underneath stairwells).

The area must be cool and dry. Refer to your battery OEM instruction manual for the ambient conditions the batteries require.

SAFETY CONSIDERATIONS WHEN INSTALLING THE CABINET:

- A DANGER: Do not modify the cabinet in any way. Modifying the cabinet from its intended design creates safety hazards including, not limited to, the risk of fire, explosion, burn, or other potential bodily injuries.
- A DANGER: Do not install this cabinet onto an unlevel surface to avoid a tipping hazard.
- A WARNING: Do not use the top of the cabinet for storage. The top of the cabinet must be always free and clear of any obstructions.
- A WARNING: Do not install this cabinet onto a vehicle.
- A CAUTION: The cabinet must be plugged in and the fan operational while the cabinet is in use.
- CAUTION: The cabinet must maintain adequate external clearance (6"minimum)- DO NOT block the vents or the fan!
- ▲ CAUTION: This cabinet is for indoor use only.
- CAUTION: This product is intended to be plugged into a dedicated 120VAC/60Hz GFCI supply using a minimum14 gauge cord. (Supply cord not included with cabinet)
- CAUTION: According to California Health and Safety Code section 25249.5 et seq. ("Prop 65") and one of its enabling regulations at 27 CCR § 25600.2(b), California law requires any company to declare if their products contain certain substances, as so listed on https://oehha.ca.gov/proposition-65/proposition-65list for products sold in California. Many products have a very small percentage of the overall components that require a Prop 65 warning, such as safety cabinets. The small fusible link contains lead. This is less than 1% of the total cabinet construction.

REQUIRED UTILITIES

This product is intended to be plugged into a dedicated 120VAC/60Hz GFCI supply using a minimum14 gauge cord. (Supply cord not included with cabinet)

Flexible cords and cables must be rated for their conditions of use and their "location" (for example; dry locations, or locations exposed to direct sunlight). If you have any questions about connecting your Lithium-Ion Battery Charging Safety Cabinet to a proper power source, please contact a licensed electrician.

INTENDED USE

This Lithium-Ion Battery Charging Safety Cabinet is designed to significantly reduce the hazards resulting from a lithium-ion thermal runaway event. This cabinet is intended to function as secondary containment only for undamaged Lithium-ION Batteries and/or their OEM chargers up to the TECR (Total Energy Containment Rating). The Lithium-Ion Battery Charging Safety Cabinet 's design limits surface temperature and reduces the risk of burns to the skin in the event of a lithium-ion thermal runaway event. The risk of burns to the skin is inherent in any lithium-ion thermal runaway event.

• The maximum total capacity of this cabinet is 4kWh TECR (Total Energy Containment Rating).

This cabinet is designed to function only while the doors are closed and fully latched to ensure a complete seal along the perimeter of the gasketed surface.

This cabinet must be installed onto a sturdy and level surface, capable of withstanding the total weight of the cabinet plus the contents inside.

Follow the OEM storage requirements for each brand of batteries that you intend to place inside the cabinet. NOTICE: Our product does not supersede or replace any storage requirements or safety instructions set by the OEM battery manufacturer. Refer to the OEM battery manufacturer's terms and conditions and comply with any specialized storage needs.

- A WARNING: Do not use this cabinet to store anything other than up to the recommended maximum capacity of Lithium-ION Batteries and/or their charging bases.
- ▲ WARNING: Do not overcharge batteries- Be sure to follow all instructions for the battery per the OEM documentation.
- A WARNING: Do not stack batteries inside the cabinet.
- A WARNING: Do not store other items inside the cabinet that are not Lithium-ION batteries or a Lithium-ION battery charger.
- A WARNING: Do not store or use any combustible materials within three feet of this cabinet.
- ▲ CAUTION: This Cabinet is NOT intended to have self-closing doors. Do not install a self closing door kit onto this cabinet, as it will not function as designed and this will void the warranty.
- CAUTION: Proper training must be implemented to incorporate the use of this cabinet into your Environmental Health and Safety procedures.
- ▲ CAUTION: Shelf Capacity: 65 pounds of evenly distributed weight
- ▲ CAUTION: Inspect batteries for damage before attempting to charge/store. Do not attempt to charge or store damaged batteries. Dispose of batteries according to your local Hazardous Waste Disposal Experts.

MAINTENANCE

This cabinet should be inspected and suggested preventative maintenance performed as follows:

- Inspection of the gaskets/cabinet seals for any cracks, degradation, tears, rips or gaps in the gasket material. It is recommended that the fit of the gasketing be checked annually and adjusted if necessary to seal properly against the door surface.
- If cleaning of the gasket is desired, we recommend either dry dusting or wiping with a mild cleaning solution. Do not use a scraper, excess moisture or anything abrasive that may damage the adhesive.
- The components must be maintained to a clean and debris-free state. Wipe away any dust from accumulating onto and inside of the cabinet and its components.
- Inspect the cabinet prior to placing the cabinet into service, as well as implementing routine inspections during the life of the cabinet.
- Inspect the supply cord for any damage. If you have any concerns over the condition of the supply cord, please contact a licensed electrician to determine the condition of the cord.
- Individual usage of this cabinet will vary and the accumulation of debris/wear and tear will determine the frequency of maintenance required. It is recommended to inspect this cabinet weekly to determine the necessary frequency of maintenance for your installation.

Failure to adequately maintain and care for the Lithium-Ion Battery Charging Cabinet, including its components, may result in the warranty being voided.

Doors won't close?

If you are having trouble getting the doors to close and latch properly, please first ensure that the cabinet is level and all feet are securely making solid contact with the surface of the table. If the cabinet can rock or flex in any way the doors will not function properly.

Check the gaskets to make sure they are all intact and in good condition, and that nothing is obstructing the doors.

Fan/Power strip not on?

Confirm that the unit is correctly plugged into a dedicated 120VAC/60Hz GFCI supply using a minimum14 gauge cord (supply cord not included with cabinet).

Ensure nothing is obstructing the fan from freely operating. Do not insert any objects into the fan housing. Check the power button on the power strip to ensure it is positioned to the "On" position.
