
## **INSTRUCTIONS**

#### PLEASE READ THESE INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY



#### Side handle

The side handle must be fixed on the same side as the swivel casters with brakes.



#### Casters

All 26", 37" and 64" cabinets are supplied with heavy duty casters, two fixed casters and two swivel casters with brakes. All 53" cabinets are supplied with four heavy duty swivel casters, whereof two with brakes.



#### How to remove a drawer

- 1. Pull the drawer fully open.
- 2. Push the drawer release plate on the slide, then pull out the drawer.

#### How to re-install a drawer

- 1. Pull out the slides fully, all parts.
- 2. Engage the drawer slides and close the drawer completely.



#### Lubrication

It is important for a smooth operation of the slides to lubricate them periodically with a light grease or petroleum jelly. This should be done at least twice a year or more frequently depending on usage.

#### Fixing brackets


When using a top or middle box on top of a cabinet, always use the correct fixing bracket to secure your storage.

#### **Combination lock**

The tool storage is equipped with a combination lock or key lock. It is possible to switch between combination lock or key lock.

#### How to change the code on a combination lock



The original password is preset to 010

Switch in position N

Push switch to S to reset with new password

Push switch to N to lock the new password

  - 15" drawer max. load 30kg / 66 lbs.
  - 26" drawer max. load 30kg / 66 lbs. (Top and Middle box)
  - 26" drawer max. load 40kg / 88 lbs.
  - 37" drawer max. load 25kg / 55 lbs. (75mm drawer)
  - 37" drawer max. load 40kg / 88 lbs. (154mm drawer)
  - 53" drawer max. load 40kg / 88 lbs.
- **DO NOT** slam the drawers as they will not lock and slight damage to lock bar tabs or lock pockets may occur.
- Load the product evenly from bottom and up. Unbalanced product may tip when being moved.
- **DO NOT** open more than one drawer at a time. With more than one drawer open,the product may become unstable and tip. Causing serious injury.
- **DO NOT** stand or climb on the product. The product may tip, and you can fall.
- DO NOT step on any drawer. The product may tip, and you can fall.
- Wear safety glasses when assembling the product.
- Only lift the product while it is empty using proper lifting device.
- **DO NOT** mount this product on a truck bed or any other moving object.
- **DO NOT** move this product before you have closed and locked all the drawers. The drawers could come open and the product will be unstable and may tip.
- Make sure that the casters are locked when the product is not being moved. This will prevent the product from moving unexpectedly.
- **DO NOT** alter this product in any manner.
- Make sure that you keep the product on a level surface. If the product is stored or moved on an uneven surface it may be unstable and tip.
- Be careful before closing any moving parts. Remove hands before closing drawers and cover.
- The product must be empty when being transported.
- Properly secure when transporting.
