• The wall-mounted remote control and the Cover Connect application are control devices for operating an automatic pool cover to prevent unsafe access to the pool.



SWIMMING POOL SAFETY STANDARD (NF P 90-308)

- The wall-mounted remote control must be fitted at a fixed location near the pool.
- When using the wall-mounted remote control or the Cover Connect mobile application, the user must have an unobstructed view of the pool to make sure no one is in the pool during operation.
- The device must be used only by a responsible adult. The user must lock and keep the control devices paired with the cover out of reach of children. When the pool cover is open, the physical presence of a responsible adult is essential.
- The control device, wall-mounted remote control or Cover Connect mobile application must be in constant contact with each other when the cover is being closed.
- If the cover or the application is not working or is temporarily unavailable and the
 pool cannot be covered to prevent unsafe access, take the necessary measures to
 prevent access to the pool by bathers, especially children, until the system returns to
 normal operation.
- Caution: The pool is safe only when the cover is closed, locked and correctly installed
 according to the manufacturer's instructions. The cover must be closed systematically
 in case of absence from home, including momentary absences. The cover must
 always be completely open or completely closed and must never be left half-open or
 half-closed.

ELECTRICAL INSTALLATION STANDARD (NF C15-100)

- The wall-mounted remote control receiver must be connected by a qualified electrician according to the NF C 15-100 standard.
- Caution: Before touching the wires, disconnect the 230V power supply from the box.

END OF SERVICE LIFE

- Do not throw the product in the rubbish or in municipal recycling bins.
- · Options:
 - Take the used unit to a waste disposal site
 - Give the device to a social purpose enterprise.
 - Return the used unit to the distributor when purchasing a new one.

COVER



- 30 seconds to enter the new code.
- The code must be a combination of 4 keys.
- After 30 seconds, the LEDs stop flashing, the keypad locks and if no new code is entered, the old code is maintained.
- If you forget the code, you always have the option of creating a new one.

BATTERY LEVEL

Green LED flashing during opening/closing: Battery OK.



Red LED flashing during opening/closing: Battery level low, needs changing.


CHANGING THE BATTERY





•If the base is reconnected the wrong way round, a red LED will flash on the inside and outside of the remote control.

Be careful with the keypad base when opening the box and changing the battery.



The remote control must be supply in the form of a SAFT-make lithium battery, model LS14500.

Fluidra code: 907676 Non-rechargeable.

Do not use a 1.5V alkaline battery. In winter, remove the battery and store the wall-mounted remote control out of the cold.







• Cover Connect is an application for remote automatic cover operation using a mobile device (smartphone or tablet running on Android or iOS) with the latest updates.









- Use the application from a position where you have a full and unobstructed view of the pool and make sure no one gets into the pool when the cover is being opened or closed. A distance limitation is applied between the terminal and the wall-mounted remote control.
- For best application performance, the mobile device must be pointing at the wall-mounted remote control while the cover is being opened or closed. Performance may vary depending on the mobile device used as each one has its own technical specifications and performance options.
- The cost of all the software and hardware required to download and use the application, together with all other related costs, including telecommunications and subscriber costs, are exclusively on the user's account.
- If the cover is not working or if there is a power cut or similar and you cannot close the cover or make the pool safe, take the necessary measures to prevent anyone getting into the pool, especially children, until the system returns to normal operation.
- The user must also fit the cover with a wired key control system to operate the cover if the paired terminal is unavailable.
- FLUIDRA would like to point out that technology, the services available and applicable legislation are constantly changing. - Enable Bluetooth on your mobile device, switch the app on and follow the instructions.
- Read and accept the general terms and conditions of use.
- Pairing:
 - Press the "start" or "stop" button on the wall-mounted remote control.
 - If you only have the app, turn the key of the switch on the winder's stand.
 - Set a 4-digit password.



Unfasten the safety clamps. Press OK.





Press and hold: pool opens/closes

The application operating mode depends on the receiver mode (long/short press). (see p.16).

Switching the app off stops the impulse response function. (Receiver in mode 2 or 3).

Remember to lock the safety clamps in position once the cover has been closed.



- This cover is not a substitute for common sense or for individual responsibility. Its purpose is not to substitute the vigilance of parents and/or responsible adults, who remain essential for the protection of young children.
- The cover must always be closed when the owner is away from home, even if only for a moment.
- Opening and closing of the cover must only be carried out by a responsible adult.
- Check that there are no swimmers or foreign bodies in the pool before, during and after operation.
- Keep cover operation equipment well out of reach of children.
- Climbing, walking, or jumping onto the security cover is strictly forbidden.
- When a malfunction has been noted that prevents the closing of the cover and risks the safety of
 the pool, or if the equipment or the pool is temporarily unavailable, adopt all the necessary
 measures to prevent access to the pool until the cover has been repaired.
- Respect recommended water levels.
